

# Stained Glass Besamim Holder

**Grade Level:** Early Childhood

## **Description:**

An original idea for a besamim holder that looks like stained glass. The part that actually holds the besamim is made out of a cover of a juice carton.

## **Goals/Objectives:**

Students will assemble a besamim holder to reinforce knowledge about the bracha on besamim for havdalah.

## **Materials Needed:**

- Flower cut out
- Juice cartons
- Card stock
- Bisomim
- Glue
- Markers/Crayons



## **Instructions:**

1. Copy flower template as needed.
2. Cut out flower and color.
3. Cut out the small circle in the middle of the flower.
4. Cut off the cap of an orange juice carton in a circle as shown in the diagram at the right.
5. Glue the circle with the cap onto a paper that is smaller than the flower.
6. Place the orange juice cap underneath the flower and push it through the center hole.
7. Attach from the back with tape.
8. Open the cap and pour besamim inside.
9. Optional- Laminate.
