

Lag Ba'Omer Fire Jar

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Grade Level: Early Childhood

Description:

An innovative project where a clear jar is decorated with tissue paper to look like a fire. Cut-outs of children dancing in a circle are pasted onto the outside of the jar and a candle is lit inside the jar. This produces the effect of a bonfire which will help children visualize dancing around the fire. (Note: If the candle is lit, parental supervision is required!)

Goals/Objectives:

Students will use fine motor coordination to assemble a project that will reinforce a theme of dancing around a Lag Ba'Omer fire.

Materials Needed:

- Jelly/honey-jar
- Red, orange and yellow tissue paper
- Candle
- Picture of people holding hands
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Teacher should cut out shapes of a flame from the colored tissue paper.
2. Give kids the jars and have them glue on the tissue paper all around (make sure the pointy side of the paper is always up).
3. Draw or take pictures of the backs of kids dancing. Cut out the silhouettes.
4. Stick on the dancing kids around the jar.
5. Place the candle inside.
