

Bracha upon Seeing a Rainbow: Hanging Craft

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Grade Level: Early Childhood, Elementary

Description:

Reinforce the Zocher Habris Bracha said upon seeing a rainbow with this simple, yet adorable, craft! This project features a cloud made out of white paper circles which are pieced together to form a cloud shape. Colored strips of paper, representing a rainbow are attached to the bottom of the cloud while a string with which to hang the project is attached at the top. In the center of the cloud the Zocher Habris Bracha is prominently displayed. Use as part of a unit on rain, a Brachos unit, or for Parshas Noach.

What to download

Goals/Objectives:

Students will create rainbow as a reminder of the Bracha said upon seeing a rainbow.

Materials Needed:

- Circular shaped object in desired size - to trace
- White construction paper
- Red, orange, yellow, green, blue and purple construction paper – cut into strips
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Single hole punch
- Ribbon
- Words of the bracha – written neatly or typed
- Coloring supplies - optional

Instructions:

1. Have students trace the round object onto the white paper.
2. If students are capable, have them cut out the circles.
3. Have students arrange and glue the circles into the shape of a cloud.
4. Have students glue the strips of colored paper in the correct order to the cloud.
5. Affix Bracha onto the cloud.
6. Punch a hole at the top of the cloud.
7. String a ribbon through the cloud.
8. Hang the project from the ceiling.

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
