

Shavuos Dominoes: Game

Grade Level: Early Childhood – 2nd Grade

Description:

A domino game whose cards feature Shavuos-related pictures. Send it home before Yom Tov for some Shavuos fun! Available with a concise lesson plan as a non-editable PDF, or without the lesson plan as an editable Word document.

Goals/Objectives:

Students will have Oneg Yom Tov by playing with their very own Shavuos-related domino set.

Instructions:

1. Print cards.
2. Laminate.
3. Cut out.
4. Game play
 - a) Turn all of the game cards upside down and shuffle.
 - b) Each player must draw six game cards.
 - c) Set the remaining cards on the side.
 - d) The first player must choose a card to play first by laying it on the table.
 - e) The next player must match one side of one of his/her cards to one side of the card that was played.
 - f) If a player has a playable domino, he must play it. If s/he does not have a playable domino he/she must pick a card from the pile.
 - g) Play continues with players taking turns matching a card to a card on the table.
 - h) If the game becomes blocked, and no more plays can be made, all players count their cards and the player with the least cards left wins. Otherwise, the first player to finish his/her hand wins.
