

Multi-Purpose T-Shirt Bag

Grade Level: Elementary

Description:

This bag is made out of a t-shirt! This bag can be used for a variety of purposes, including: bringing home projects on Erev Shabbos, carrying clothing for a Shabbos sleepover, as a bag for bags or for recycling. You may also use it to depict the Bnai Yisroel walking out of Mitzrayim carrying a bag of matza and marror. Use this project as an opportunity to teach students about reducing, reusing, and recycling; the old t-shirt gets a new lease on life when it turns into a bag!

What to Download:

Goals/Objectives:

Students will create a bag that can be used for a variety of purposes.

Materials Needed:

- Scissors
- Old t-shirt
- Fabric paint

Instructions:

1. Cut off the sleeves, neck and bottom hem of the shirt.
2. Cut strips at the bottom of the shirt (not too thin) and tie each strip to the one beneath it, so that the bottom of the t-shirt will be closed.
3. Decorate the shirt as desired.
